

Tulle Skirted Designs

Im showing the Cutie mermaid princess in this, but the same idea applies to all the tulle skirt designs.

1. Stitch out the design as you would any normal applique until you get to the tulle placement step. Use the stitchmap picture if you are unsure of where it is. You can use as much or as little tulle as you want, there is no set amount. For this, I used a 8 inch long and the entire width the 52" wide tulle comes in from the roll. I folded the tulle back and forth to make it all gathered up and then taped it down with regular scotch tape.

It is okay to have it hang over the outline placement line, but make sure it doesn't go over the side edges of the line.



2. Stitch out the tack down step for the tulle and then trim



along the line. Your machine will go right through the tape and you can peel it off later. I find it easiest to leave the tulle taped down under the tack down stitches where her skirt will be hanging down so it doesn't get in the way of the hair stitching!

3. Stitch out the rest of the design like you would any normal applique.



4. Peel off any excess tape and trim the bottom of the tulle to the length you would like and you are done!
